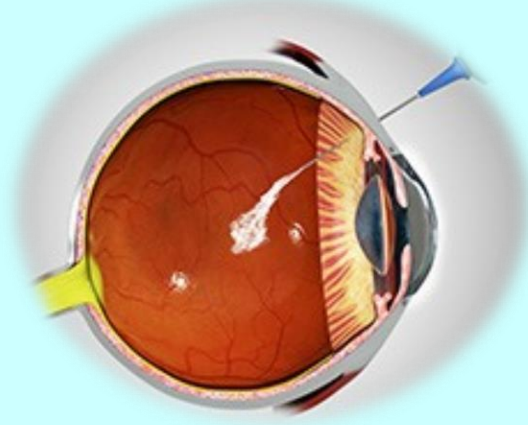

Care After Intraocular Injection

- Two hours after the injection, the eye dressing should be opened and the drops should be started immediately and one drop should be given every 4 hours (only during waking hours) until the next 5 days.
- After the injection, in case of pain, you can use Painkillers(Analgesia) such as Acetaminophen or Gelofen ,etc.
- In case of increased pain, new eye redness or reduced vision (compared to before injection), immediately refer to the nearest ophthalmologist or emergency room.
- 6 hours after the injection, the patient can wash his face, and there is no prohibition for ablution and bathing, but avoid water entering the eyes as much as possible.
- The effect of the injected drug does not appear immediately; Therefore, if vision does not increase immediately after injection, there is no need to refer.
- There is no specific food and activity restriction.
- There is no need to stop aspirin or other drugs before and after injection.
